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This is a basic risk assessment to help you plan your visit to U-boat Story. It is a general outline and you will need to add your own details. Schools will remain responsible for children when visiting U-boat Story in organised school trips and are encouraged to undertake their own risk assessment prior to the visit. A complimentary ticket is available for teachers wishing to make a familiarisation visit.

The Woodside Terminal and U-boat Story is split in to operation areas for ease of risk assessing:-

- Area 1 Consists of the ticket hall, café, mezzanine and viewing platform.
- Area 2 Consists of the U-boat Story visitor centre and the U-boat Story Deck area.
- Area 3 Consists of the link span and stage.
- Area 4 Consists of the Car Park.

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Guidance Notes for Assessors

Key: **H = High Risk** Intolerable area. Risks cannot be justified, immediate action needs to be taken.
 M = Medium Risk Uncertain area. Actions to be taken to control the risks to as low a level as is reasonably practicable
 L = Low Risk Tolerable area. Further actions may not be required, but can be taken to keep the risk low. In particular, monitoring will probably be required to ensure that the control measures are working
